In the last decades, the relationships between the market, society and the State have constituted one of the principal topics in debates concerning Social Sciences. The State's role in the economic and social system has always been the subject of controversy, something which has been strengthened by the importance it gained in the 20th century. The economic and social policies that emerged from the State's action in society, as well as the mechanisms used for its implementation, opened a vast field of research that seeks new analyses and interpretations. Reflecting on the changes that have occurred in the relationships between market, society and State could provide an important contribution to the redefining that occurred with the role the State assumed in different historical contexts. Therefore, the Organizing Committee calls for submissions also focusing on this important thematic considering the current discussion around European institutions.

Submissions of individual papers and panel proposals on other topic in the areas of Economic History and Social History are encouraged. **Thematic panel proposals with more than 5 papers are not accepted.**

Both members and non-members of the APHES can submit paper proposals.

The proposals should be accompanied by an abstract of (maximum) 500 words (including 4 keywords, indicating the objective, theoretical focus and empirical support, if relevant) and a brief CV (1 page limit) of the author, or in the case of various authors, of the main author. The deadline for the submission of the proposals runs until 31 May 2013. Submissions should be sent to: 33aphes@gmail.com. It is possible to submit more than one communication. In the program the author's name appears only once. A 15 minute limit for the discussion of each communication is suggested. There are available grants for students in the amount of registration fees (please consult <http://www.aphes.pt>).

Papers will be selected by 30 June 2013 and the complete paper (maximum 7,500 words, including notes) should be submitted by 15 October 2013. Papers running for the APHES award are excluded from this rule, since they have a maximum limit of 12,000 words. The text will only be available on the Meeting Minutes website if one of the authors attends.
